STUDENTS

We are a great fit for students seeking fieldwork experiences related to social work, counseling, psychology, substance use treatment, peer-focused recovery services, criminal justice, and other similar courses of study.

We meet training needs of most bachelor, master and some doctoral students.

- Students typically work 1-3 days/week for 4-12 months, accruing anywhere from 300 to 1,000 hours of training.
- Every student gets as much client contact as possible, including services like psycho-education, skill building, advocacy, case management, assessment, treatment planning, advocacy, and more.

Students receive direct service opportunities, clinical supervision and honest feedback about their skills.
